Directions to Byrnes Dental Laboratory

From North
M40 junction 8a.
Take the A40/A418 exit to Thame/Aylesbury/Oxford.
At A40/A418 take the 3rd exit onto A40/A418.
After approx 500 yards turn right to Wheatley.
Ashurst Court is approx 300 yards on the left.

From South
M40 junction 8a.
Take the second turning signposted to Oxford A40 Wheatley.
Follow this road for approx 400 yards until you see a sign
for Wheatley.
Turn right and Ashurst Court is approx 300 yards on the left.

From Oxford
Take the A40 out of Oxford signposted London.
Take the turning to Wheatley.
On leaving the A40 turn right, back over the A40.
At roundabout turn left - this is the London Road.
Follow this road through the village. Once over a small bridge
take next turning right into Ashurst Court.
